



# SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PACKAGE

With our Wilde Field Horsemanship Scholarship Program, you too can now contribute to growing this horsemanship philosophy within the dedicated equestrian community and help horses in need along the way. Through the amazing work of our donors, we want to make an impactful investment, on their behalf, in the right person (or horse) who can carry the gift of knowledge forward and contribute positively to the equestrian community for years to come.

## OUR MISSION:

To facilitate the development of horsemanship through the Jonathan Field Horsemanship program.

For the Human: To invest in the education of a unique individual who has the capacity and potential to help numerous horses for years to come.

For the Horse: To invest in the healthy development of a special horse **in need** who has the potential to lead an active and happy life.

***This scholarship is for participation in a Jonathan Field Horsemanship event or one-on-one training directly with Jonathan. This may include ongoing educational opportunities for the rider as well. Funds will be awarded based on need and will cover between 50%-100% of the cost of the event or training fee.***

All donated funds (100%) will be allocated to the scholarship program. Scholarship funds which have not been awarded/dispensed by end of year will carry forward to the following year's scholarship program.

*\*This scholarship is a private program and is not currently registered as a charity. As such, we are unable to provide tax receipts for donations at this time.*

## SELECTION CRITERIA:

Scholarship recipients will be carefully selected by an approved panel. Selection will be based on the following criteria:

1. An outstanding individual or youth who does not have financial means to pursue an education within the Jonathan Field Horsemanship program. Riders must be at least 15 years of age and both horse & rider must meet the minimum requirements for a Course 1 clinic.



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2. Focus will be on individuals who have numerous volunteer hours and a significant potential to help numerous horses for years to come. This person must demonstrate a commitment to the ongoing betterment of the horse and horsemanship community
3. In the case of an equine scholarship recipient, it must be a unique horse who is not otherwise able to be helped but who has potential to develop into a partner and lead a positive life.
4. Scholarship recipients and/or the horse must be capable of travelling to either the Field Horsemanship Centre in British Columbia, or to another Jonathan Field Event location.
5. Recipients must have the capacity to embrace ongoing learning opportunities beyond a single event.

## APPLICATION PROCESS:

Individuals may apply for this scholarship on behalf of themselves, or a person/horse they would like to nominate. Applications will be accepted throughout the calendar year, however applications will only be reviewed every 6 months. If the number of approved applicants exceed available scholarships, a lottery will be held to select those who will be awarded a scholarship for the upcoming term.

To apply please submit the following:

1. A completed Scholarship Application Form
2. A photo of the applicant or nominee and the horse
3. A summary (500 word max) outlining their background, goals, reason for applying, and why the individual or horse may be a good candidate for this scholarship

*\* Applicants must be willing and able to travel to the Field Horsemanship Centre in British Columbia or to an existing Jonathan Field Horsemanship event location.*

The successful applicant(s) must be willing to submit a post event letter (500 word max) identifying what the event meant to them, 3 key lessons learned, how their horse has benefited from the program and submit a photo of themselves and their horse for use by Jonathan Field Horsemanship.

Applicants will receive a confirmation notice once their form has been received. Successful scholarship recipients will be contacted directly with details pertaining to their scholarship award and to coordinate their participation in their selected Jonathan Field Horsemanship event.

Successful applicants will be notified directly by Jonathan Field Horsemanship.

After attending their awarded event, the applicant must submit a post-event letter (500 word max) identifying:

- what the event meant to them
- 3 key lessons learned
- how their horse has benefited from the program
- provide a photo of themselves and their horse for use by Jonathan Field Company Ltd.
